## **Turning E-Waste** into Work

Substation33 uses e-waste reuse and recycling to create work opportunities in the Logan region, diverting over 1 million kg of e-waste from landfill over the past 8 years. E-waste is the fastest growing waste stream in the world, and only 20% is currently recycled through the appropriate channels.

Substation33 is expert at networking & is relationshiporiented enterprise across all areas of its operations. Impacts are realised by working with a diverse cross-section of individuals, organisations, businesses, & institutions.

It fosters social capital within a circular economy framework that aligns with 11 of the 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) defined by the UN.

Since 2012 we have created employment pathways for marginalised & disadvantaged jobseekers via three streams:

- Environmental: Collection, processing, reuse, & recycling of electronics that would otherwise go to landfill.
- Social: Support for diverse groups including training & employment pathways for people experiencing complex barriers to participation.
- Enterprise: Design, development & production of innovative engineered products that solve real problems for customers and partners.

## Demonstrating Innovation for Impact
